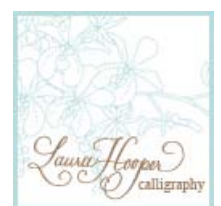
Perfect right? And the best part...the couple was thoughtful, gracious and totally in love. So it was beautiful inside and out! Here are a few more words from [Enna](#)...

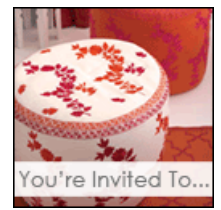
